15. Response to Public Consultation on the Part 2 Local Plan for Corby – Emerging Draft Options

The Principal Planning Officer (Local Plan) presented a report providing an update on the progress of the Part 2 Local Plan for Corby, it would include locally specific policies and site allocations that would guide the future of the Borough up to 2031 and compliment strategic policies as set out in the North Northamptonshire Joint Core strategy 2011-2031.

A total of 38 responses had been received during the consultation period, the Principal Planning Officer (Local Plan) highlighted some specific areas of the report which had brought in responses from Parish Councils, Sport England, Environment Agency and Natural England.

Following consideration and further analysis of the comments received the next stage would be to prepare a plan for publication and publish it under Regulation 19, this would be the document the Council would consider ready for examination.

The Publication Plan would be published together with the other 'proposed for submission' documents for a six week period to seek representations for the soundness and legal compliance of the Plan before it could be submitted to the Planning Inspectorate for examination.

Members commented on the content of the report and Councillor Rutt specifically requested further information on land in 2.28 of the report regarding Middleton. The Principal Planning Officer (Local Plan) said he would provide Councillor Rutt with the information through email.

Chair commented that the responses were less than the previous version and the officer responded that there had been meetings with some of the consultees which had resulted in changes which were now incorporated within the document.
