SHOPS ACTS 1950 TO 1965

CORBY DISTRICT (EXEMPTION FROM HALF DAY

CLOSING) ORDER 1979

W H E R E A S the CORBY DISTRICT COUNCIL is the Authority for the District for the purposes of the Shops Act 1950 (as amended by the Shops (Early Closing Days) Act 1965)

The said Council having reason to believe that a majority of the occupiers of shops of each of the classes specified in the Schedule hereto within the Corby District (hereinafter called "the District") were in favour of being wholly exempted from the provisions of Section 1 of the Shops Act 1950 (as amended by the Shops (Early Closing Days) Act 1965) took steps to ascertain the wishes of such occupiers

The majority of the occupiers of shops of each class specified in the said Schedule within the District were in favour of such exemption as aforesaid

N O W THEREFORE THE COUNCIL DO HEREBY ORDER:

(1) That the classes of shops specified in the said Schedule within the District shall be exempted wholly from the provisions of Section 1 of the Shops Act 1950 (as amended by the Shops (Early Closing Days) Act 1965) relating to early closing days.

(2) This Order may be cited as the Corby District (Exemption from Half-Day Closing) Order 1979 and shall come into force on the 9th day of October One thousand nine hundred and seventy-nine.

(3) For the purposes of this Order "food" means articles and substances (cooked or uncooked) intended for human consumption, including chocolate, chocolate and sugar confectionery, ice cream (including wafers and edible containers) ice lollies and similar products, and including also drink (including intoxicating liquors) and ingredients for the preparation of food or drink, but not including articles or substances used only as drugs or medicines.


SCHEDULE


Class of Shop

(a) Food Shops, i.e. shops in which the principal trade or business carried on is the retail sale of food (whether or not any other retail trade or business is also carried on therein).

(b) Shops in which any retail trade or business (including the provision of services) other than the sale of food is carried on (whether or not the sale of food is also carried on therein).

The Corby District Council (Exemption from Half Day Closing) Order 1979

CORBY DISTRICT COUNCIL in pursuance of their powers under Section 1 (4) of the Shops Act 1950 HEREBY make the following order:-

1. That the classes of shops (specified in the schedule hereto and) situate within the District of Corby shall be exempted wholly from the provisions of Section 1 of the Shops Act 1950 (as amended by the Shops (Early Closing Days) Act 1965 relating to early closing days).
2. This order may be cited as the Corby District Council (Exemption from Half Day Closing) Order 1979 and shall come into force on the Ninth day of October One thousand nine hundred and seventy nine.

THE SCHEDULE

Classes of Shops

Shops, excluding those shops in which the only trade or business carried on is trade or business of any of the classes specified in the First schedule to the Shops Act 1950, situate in this the Corby District.
