



**LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT 1982**

**HIGHWAY AUTHORITY CONDITIONS FOR STREET TRADING CONSENT OF  
CATERING UNITS ON THE HIGHWAY**

1. The catering unit must be sited in a safe location having due regard to the visibility splays of nearby junctions and exits from adjoining premises and the visibility of drivers using the main carriageway. Regard must be had to the position of both the catering unit and the parked vehicles of customers using the facility.
2. The siting of the unit, and its use by its customers vehicles, must not be likely to cause damage to the highway, particularly grass verges.
3. The catering unit must not be sited on a section of highway that is subject to a traffic regulation order that prohibits the use of the unit or its customer's vehicles, such as parking restrictions.
4. The catering unit must be manned at all times.
5. The catering unit must be maintained in a roadworthy condition, kept in good repair and condition, and shall be removed from the highway overnight.
6. The catering unit and its operation must be in accordance with the appropriate food hygiene regulations and the guidance notes on the Keeping and Use of Liquefied Petroleum Gas in Mobile Catering Units.
7. All refuse and waster, whether liquid or solid shall be stored and disposed in a proper manner in accordance with the appropriate legislative requirements. In particular liquid waste shall not be disposed of into street gullies or onto the ground.
8. The trader shall take all reasonable steps to keep the site free from litter and a suitable litter bin shall be provided adjacent to the unit.
9. No signs at all shall be placed on the highway (includes the grass verge) or fixed to any street furniture or traffic signs advertising the catering unit.
10. The trader shall have a valid public liability cover for a minimum of £5m.
11. The County Council can require the catering unit to be removed at any time in connection with carrying out its duty as the highway authority.
12. A statutory undertaker can require the catering unit to be removed at any time in connection with carrying out its duties.
