<b>Document title:</b>	Publication Draft (Pre-Submission) Part 2 Local Plan for Corby
<b>Subject matter:</b>	<p>The Part 2 Local Plan for Corby follows on and supports the adopted North Northamptonshire Joint Core Strategy, which is the strategic Part 1 Local Plan for North Northamptonshire, providing the big picture for development across North Northamptonshire in the period 2011 to 2031. The Part 2 Local Plan for Corby takes this forward in more detail with non-strategic development allocations and a number of detailed policies to manage development in accordance with the vision, strategy and strategic policies in the Joint Core Strategy.</p> <p>Corby Borough Council is now publishing the Publication Draft (Pre-Submission) Part 2 Local Plan and its accompanying Sustainability Appraisal and Habitats Regulation Assessment. It is known as Regulation 19, and it's the final opportunity to make representations on the draft plan before it is submitted to a Planning Inspector for consideration (through an Examination in Public).</p> <p>This version of the Part 2 Local Plan reflects amendments and updates made following the consultation on the Regulation 18 Emerging Draft Options which took place between July and August 2018.</p>
