## One Corby Grants

---

### SYNOPSIS

To update on Core and Devolved Organisations, consider for approval the Small, Arts and Health and Wellbeing grant applications.

#### 1. Relevant Background Details

Corby Borough Council currently grant funds Core and Devolved organisations whose activities support the community. The Core and Devolved organisations are reviewed every three years with grant funding agreed annually, subject to the Council's agreed budget.

The Council's Small Grants Fund supports community applications up to £500 to assist with the costs of small community initiatives and Arts Grants up to £750. This funding is open to not for profit individuals/groups and organisations that are delivering community and art projects within the Corby Borough.

The Health and Wellbeing grant funding supports groups who link in with one of the health priorities and funding can be applied for up to £2,000 per project.

#### 2. Report

##### (i) Devolved Community Centres

A Health and Safety Audit will be completed on all the devolved community centres starting in November with The Autumn Centre. This will be undertaken by the Councils Health and Safety Resilience Team and a report on each audit sent to Council Officers.

##### (ii) Core Organisations

###### Core Review

The Core Review is open for applications with short-listing due to be completed in December 2018 and presentations from organisations on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2019.

Organisations will be kept informed of their progress throughout the process with successful organisations being funded from April 1<sup>st</sup> 2019.

##### (iii) Grant Applications

New grant applications received are included in the Appendices for Members for consideration. Funding available is as follows:

###### (a) Small Grants

The remaining small grants budget is £11,959.

###### (b) Health and Wellbeing Grants

The remaining Health and Wellbeing grants budget for this financial year is £9,475

###### (c) Arts Grants

The remaining arts grants budget for this financial year is £2,000. However the full pot set aside from previous year's savings is £10,000 to cover this year and following three years. The new grants application received total £2,948 and Members will therefore need to agree to bring forward an additional £948 if wishing to approval all applications in full.

### 3. Issues to be taken into account:-

#### ***Policy Priorities***

The Council's One Corby Corporate Plan includes improving Health and Wellbeing and reducing health and social inequalities, reducing anti-social behaviour in supporting safer stronger communities and continuing with the regeneration within the Borough.

#### ***Financial***

There is a remaining balance for this financial year of £11,959 for Small grants and £2,000 for Arts grants and £9,475 for Health and Wellbeing projects.

Three grants were approved at the September Grants Committee that were pending match funding and are still awaiting confirmation; Small Grants – Fishing Group £115, Essence of Corby £500 and Health and Wellbeing grants - ArtReach £2000.

All the submitted accounts from the devolved centres have been sent to the Council's Financial Service to be checked. Any concerns will be reported at the next Grants Committee.

#### ***Risk***

Organisations are unsettled by the proposal from Government for two unitary authorities. Organisations are concerned that current ongoing support and financial assistance from the Council will be reduced or withdrawn leaving the future of the organisations uncertain.

#### ***Legal***

There are legal agreements in place for grant funded organisations which are reviewed annually.

#### ***Performance Information***

All Core and Devolved Organisations are required to provide to the Council details of performance twice a year. As part of the grant monitoring, all grant funded organisations are requested to submit their annual accounts. This identifies the income and expenditure of each organisation and if there are any concerns the Council has in the past asked for monthly monitoring.

#### ***Best Value***

The Council's policy on devolving facilities and services to the local community where possible is in line with the principles of best value.

#### ***Equalities***

Organisations are encouraged to adopt an equal opportunities policy or have an equality statement. All projects supported must not discriminate or refuse participation to any members of the community.

#### ***Human Rights***

Not applicable to this report.

#### ***Sustainability***

The grants awarded are provided to support sustainable work within the Corby Community.

#### ***Community Safety***

All organisations assist in supporting community safety initiatives.

### 4. Conclusion

The Core and Devolved facilities continue to operate with the assistance of volunteer management committees. There are some concerns now being raised from these committees regarding what impact the Northamptonshire County Council cuts will have on

them and also what will happen to the community centres and other services if Corby becomes part of a Unitary Authority. Although there is uncertainty around future delivery Officers are encouraging committees to continue as normal and they will be updated when decisions are made.
