Terms & Conditions

Water Hazards

The areas marked by the red stakes on the right hand side of the 1st, 9th, 11th, 12th and 13th fairways and the back of the 8th green are deemed to be lateral water hazards. Rule 26 applies. All other areas marked by yellow stakes, whether filled with water or not are deemed to be water hazards – Rule 26 applies.

Out of Bounds

A ball is out of bounds if it comes to rest in or beyond the boundary ditches marked by white posts on the left of the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 6th, 13th, 14th, 15th, 16th and 17th holes; on a line with or beyond the white posts on the left of the entire length of the 18th hole.

The Parley Burn

The ditch known as the Parley Burn on the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th holes is a water hazard in which Rule 26 applies. The sleepers are considered part of the Burn.

Stones in the Bunkers

Stones in the bunkers are movable obstructions and Rule 24 – 1 applies. A ball may be lifted cleaned and dropped within one club length of the nearest point of relief not nearer the hole without penalty if:

- It lies on any backfilled ditch, Rule 25 – 1b(i) (ground under repair).
- It lies in any open ditch that is not marked by hazard stakes or classed as a boundary ditch, Rule 25 – 1b(i).
- It lies on a cinder/tarmac path, sand slits or tractor marks or winter green. Rule 25-1.
- A fence or staked tree, wooden hut or blue marker post interferes with the players stance or area of their intended swing Rule 24 – 2b(i) (immovable obstruction).

General Rules for Play

- **BLUE STAKES** 150yds to centre of greens
- Banks between Holes 6 and 7 and 10 and 11 are G.U.R.
- Free drop if your ball lands in Rabbit Holes / Deer Hoof marks in bunkers
- Replace all divots
- Keep trolleys off the greens tees and bunkers
- Rake bunkers after use and replace rake
- Repair pitch marks
- Smart casual clothes to be worn at all times
- **GREENKEEPERS HAVE RIGHT OF WAY AT ALL TIMES**
- No refunds will be given due to adverse weather conditions.

SLOW PLAY

- Any game losing one hole on the game in front **MUST** allow the game behind to play through
- Sharing clubs is not allowed – one player per bag
- Please play quickly, quietly and courteously.

Members of the public who use the course outside of opening hours do so at their own risk and the Council accepts no liability for accident or injury.
